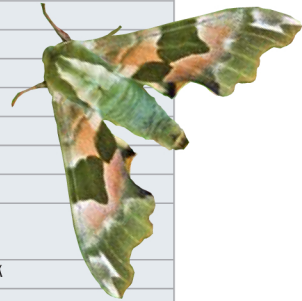


# CATERPILLAR FOODPLANTS: MOTHS

TREES AND SHRUBS	
Ash, <i>Fraxinus excelsior</i>	Centre-barred Sallow, Coronet
Apple, <i>Malus domestica</i>	Eyed Hawk-moth
Barberry, <i>Berberis</i> spp.	Scarce Tissue
Beech, <i>Fagus sylvatica</i>	Clay Triple-lines, Barred Sallow
Birch, <i>Betula</i> spp.	Lesser Swallow Prominent, Grey Dagger, Vapourer
Blackthorn, <i>Prunus spinosa</i>	Blue-bordered Carpet, Peppered Moth, Chinese Character
Bramble, <i>Rubus fruticosus</i>	Peach Blossom, Buff Arches
Hawthorn, <i>Crataegus monogyna</i>	Swallow-tailed Moth, Brimstone Moth, Feathered Thorn
Hazel, <i>Corylus avellana</i>	Scalloped Hazel, Purple Thorn
Lime, <i>Tilia</i> spp.	Lime Hawk-moth, Orange Sallow
Oak, <i>Quercus</i> spp. native deciduous	Merveille du Jour, Oak Beauty, December Moth
Privet, <i>Ligustrum vulgare</i>	Privet Hawk-moth, Willow Beauty
Willow, <i>Salix</i> spp.	Sallow Kitten, Poplar Hawk-moth, Puss Moth, Herald, Red Underwing

Clematis, cultivated varieties and Traveller's Joy <i>Clematis vitalba</i>	Small Emerald, Haworth's Pug
Comfrey, <i>Symphytum officinale</i>	Scarlet Tiger
Currant, <i>Ribes</i> spp.	Magpie, V-moth
Dog Rose, <i>Rosa canina</i>	Shoulder Stripe, Streamer, Barred Yellow
Foxglove, <i>Digitalis purpurea</i>	Foxglove Pug
Fuchsia, <i>Fuchsia</i> spp.	Elephant Hawk-moth
Garlic Mustard, <i>Alliaria petiolata</i>	Garden Carpet
Heathers, <i>Erica</i> , <i>Calluna</i> spp.	True Lover's Knot
Honeysuckle, <i>Lonicera periclymenum</i>	Early Grey, Twenty-plume Moth
Hop, <i>Humulus lupulus</i>	Currant Pug, Buttoned Snout, Buff Ermine, Pale Tussock
Ivy, <i>Hedera helix</i>	Double-striped, Old Lady
Mallow, (Common Mallow <i>Malva sylvestris</i> and Tree Mallow <i>M. arborea</i> )	Mallow
Marjoram, <i>Origanum vulgare</i>	Mint Moth
Mint, <i>Mentha</i> spp.	Mint Moth, Beautiful Plume
Ox-eye Daisy, <i>Leucanthemum vulgare</i>	<i>Dichrorampha alpinana</i>
Nettle, <i>Urtica dioica</i>	Mother of Pearl, Burnished Brass, Jersey Tiger, Beautiful Golden Y, Spectacle, Snout
Red Campion, <i>Silene dioica</i>	Rivulet
Sweet William, <i>Dianthus barbatus</i>	Varied Coronet
Mulleins, <i>Verbascum bombyciferum</i> , <i>Verbascum thapsus</i>	Mullein
Yarrow, <i>Achillea millefolium</i>	Tawny Speckled Pug
Low-growing plants such as Dandelion <i>Taraxacum officinale</i> , Dock <i>Rumex obtusifolius</i> and Plantain <i>Plantago major</i> attract a wide range of species including the Ruby Tiger, Garden Tiger, Muslin, White Ermine, and Blood-vein.
